## Whitmer Still Leads Dixon by 2 Percent (50%-48%)

(Nessel 47%- DePerno 44% and Benson 51%-Karamo 40%)

**LANSING, Mich.** — With just four days remaining before the election on Tuesday, the race continues to be very close with Republican candidate Tudor Dixon still within two percent of Democratic incumbent Governor Gretchen Whitmer in Michigan's gubernatorial election according to the most recent Mitchell-MIRS Poll of likely General Election voters conducted by Mitchell Research & Communications, Inc. Whitmer leads 50%-48% with 2 percent undecided.

Democrat incumbent Attorney General Dana Nessel is also in a very tight race with GOP candidate Mathew DePerno. Nessel leads 47%-44%. Incumbent Secretary of State Jocelyn Benson has a much stronger lead over Republican challenger Kristina Karamo (51%-40%). Support for Proposal 3 has ticked up slightly to 51% with 46% opposed and 3% not planning to vote on the proposal.

The poll was conducted using automated Interactive Voice Response (IVR) methodology calling landlines and by text messaging voter's cell phones and sending them to a SurveyMonkey poll. Data was weighted by age, gender, and race to reflect the likely voter turnout on November 8. The survey of N=658 Likely Voters was conducted November 3, 2022 and has a Margin of Error of + or -3.82% at the 95% level of confidence.

"The race continues to be tight, but Governor Whitmer has reached the important 50% threshold. Both candidates are exceptionally strong campaigners, but Whitmer is also running with an unpopular Democratic president in the White House. With a warm, partly sunny day predicted on Tuesday, Dixon has to hope for a high turnout of Election Day voters who are heavily Republican if she is going to win," Steve Mitchell, president of Mitchell Research, said.

Governor Whitmer leads by 13 percent (55%-42%) with women while Dixon leads with men by 12 percent (55%-43%). The Governor leads with early voters while Dixon has a strong lead with those who plan to vote on Election Day.

"Mid-term elections are bad for the party in the White House, in a few days we will see how difficult it was for Democrats, this year," Mitchell concluded.
